### THE RECIPE:

1 3/4 oz Stoli vodka 1/3 oz Absinthe substitute (Pernod, Herbsaint, or Absente) 1 sugar cube

### THE METHOD:

Pour the vodka into a well chilled martini glass. Place the sugar cube onto a barspoon or teaspoon, soak it with the Absinthe substitute, letting the rest dribble over into the glass, then light the sugar cube and drop it into the drink. Then things should really heat up.
